

Delegate Updates on Terms and Conditions

2. Cancellation Policy

a. Delegate Cancellation Policy

Should you wish to cancel your participation, for any reason whatsoever, the following penalties will be applied:

Cancellation on or before 5th April, 2026:

Refunds, cancellations and substitutions on or before Sunday, 5th April, 2026 are refundable, less a 20% admin fee. All refunds and cancellation requests must be submitted in writing to support@theelectricmine.com.

Cancellation after 5th April, 2026:

No refunds will be granted if requested after the cancellation deadline of 5th April, 2026 .

Substitutions can be made at any time on or before 1st May, 2026. You can do this via your registration confirmation email.

Exchanges on or after Sunday 1st May, 2026:

No substitutions can be made after Sunday, 1st May, 2026.
